Get To Know Hebron Center Trail...

For over ten years the Town of Hebron, along with private developers and the local water company have worked to establish the Hebron Center Trail system. This two-plus mile trail network passes through Veterans Park on Wall Street, continues through recently acquired open space around Hebron Center, passes by mature forests and wetlands, and travels over a new pedestrian bridge and emerges back onto Main Street just east of Ted's Supermarket. From there the trail connects to sidewalks along Main Street and Wall Street which lead back to Veterans Park. A shorter trail loop is also provided by the trail connection that passes by the Hebron Car Wash over to the Liberty Drive sidewalks and back to Main Street.

This is one of the great trails now available in Hebron. And planning is underway by the Town departments of Planning and Development and Parks and Recreation to eventually connect this trail to Burnt Hill Park trails to the north, and the Air Line Trail to the south.
